ORDER

1. Upon scrutiny, the appeal was found with defects. Subsequently Defect Notice was issued on 23.04.2026 for removal of defects. However, the appellant was unable to remove the defects in the prescribed time. Therefore, the matter was taken up for hearing in Physical Mode on 07.05.2026. Shri Chirag Mathur, Advocate appeared on behalf of the Appellant Shri Atul Kumar Agarwal.

2. During the hearing, following defects in the appeal were brought to the notice of the Counsel :-

1. Show Cause Notice seems to be invalid due to absence of signature of the issuing authority.
2. Order in Original seems to be invalid due to absence of signature of the issuing authority.
3. Pre-deposit was not found to be deposited.
4. Amount of the Court Fee paid was less.
5. Documents were not found translated in English as desired in Rule 23 of GSTAT Procedure Rules.

3. The Counsel has sought 15 days time to remove the defects. Accordingly, it is directed to remove all the defects within 15 days and refile the appeal.
