FORM OF DRESSES OR ROBES TO BE WORN BY MEMBERS
(Rule 121 under the GSTAT Procedure Rules, 2025)

In supersession of Office Order No. 114/2025 issued vide F. No. GSTAT/Procedural Rules/24-25/07 dated 30.06.2025, the following dress code is hereby prescribed during the proceedings of the Goods and Services Tax Appellate Tribunal (GSTAT): -

Members, including Vice Presidents, while discharging quasi-judicial work shall wear the following as part of their dress, which shall be sober, presentable and dignified.

I. LADY MEMBERS

(a) Black full sleeve jacket or blouse, white collar stiff or soft, with white bands, sans gown.

White blouse, with or without collar, with white bands and with a black open chest coat.

Or

(b) Sarees or long skirts (white or black or any mellow or subdued colour without any print or design) or flare (white, black or black stripped or grey) or Punjabi dress Churidar Kurta or Salwar-Kurta with or without dupatta (white or black) or traditional dress with black coat and white bands sans gown.

II. MEMBERS

(a) A black buttoned up coat, chapkan, achkan, black sherwani and white bands sans gown.

(b) A black open chest coat, white shirt, white collar, stiff or soft, and white bands sans gown.

In either case wear long trousers (white, black striped or grey) Dhoti excluding jeans.

This dress code shall be observed with the immediate effect
